Our current and completed activities

- Developing two mini-grid pico hydro projects (Mudasomwa HPP and Kabebe HPP) with installed capacity of 34 KW and 48 KW respectively in the districts of Nyaruguru and Nyamagabe in the Southern Province of Rwanda. Both mini-grids will provide electricity to about 710 Households.
- Developing three mini-grid solar projects in Nyaruguru district with a total installed capacity of 120 KW under the joint venture TIGER Power Projects Rwanda Ltd between HOBUKA Ltd and TIGER POWER. These mini-grids will provide electricity to about 800 Households. The intent is to develop at least 200 similar mini-grids in Rwanda.
- Developing the greenfield GACUMU MHPP – Micro Hydro Power Plant: 399KW; Giheta Cell, Munini Sector, Nyaruguru District in the Southern Province under the joint venture NGUVU Energy Ltd, between Hobuka Ltd and COCA Ltd
- Developing the greenfield NYIRABUGOYI MHPP: 731KW; Rambya and Kizimyamuriro Cells, Buruhukiro Sector, Nyamagabe District Southern Province by the joint venture NGUVU Energy Ltd
- Advisory services to a Consortium that is developing the 40MW gas to power project on the DRC side of Lake Kivu.
- Consultancy services for preliminary assessment of captive power potential in Rwanda.
- Advisory services to the international developer for Rusizi III (145 MW), River: Rusizi with three off-takers from Rwanda, Burundi and DRC.
- Advisory services to various international energy developers and EPC Contractors for BOT models in both generation and transmission lines projects initiated by the Government of Cameroun
